

Route map De Zwanenhof

Private transport:

De Zwanenhof is situated on the Retraitehuisweg 6 in Zenderen; a side street to the Bornerbroeksestraat located between Borne and Bornerbroek (there are road signs).

- Coming via the A1 from Deventer / Amsterdam - at the Azelo junction you take the A35/A1 (E30) direction Borne / Oldenzaal / Hengelo and follow the road signs in the direction of Bornerbroek.
- Coming via the A35 from Enschede / Hengelo / Delden - follow the A35/A1 (E30) to Borne-West / Almelo / Amsterdam. Then you turn off at exit 30 (Borne) and follow the road signs in the direction of Bornerbroek.
- Coming via the A1 from Oldenzaal - turn off at exit 30 (Borne) and follow the road signs in the direction of Bornerbroek.

Valid for the above mentioned routes: De Zwanenhof is situated on the Retraitehuisweg; a side street to the Bornerbroeksestraat. You must turn off at the AZC-Azelo (there are road signs).

- Coming from the provincial road Almelo / Borne / Hengelo - in Zenderen you turn off in the direction of Bornerbroek. After approximately 1 km turn left directly after the railroad.



Public transport:

- Airport Amsterdam Schiphol is approximately two hours to trainstation Borne.
- De Zwanenhof has a pick-up service from the train station in Borne. Please book for this service - at least 5 work days in advance - via telephone or e-mail (stating arrival- and/or departure times). This service costs € 4,00 per person per ride.
- You can also make use of the regional taxi Twente service (collective passenger transport) from the train stations in Almelo, Hengelo and Borne. You must book this service at least 1 hour in advance via the website www.regiotaxitwente.nl or via the service telephone number 0900-1814 (local rate).
- De Zwanenhof has a pick-up service from Schiphol airport in Amsterdam. This service costs € 15,00 per person per ride, if traveling together and can be booked - at least two weeks in advance - via +31742659525 or info@zwanenhof.nl (stating arrival- and/or departure times). The pick-up times will be coordinated to suit the arrival times of the various participants.
